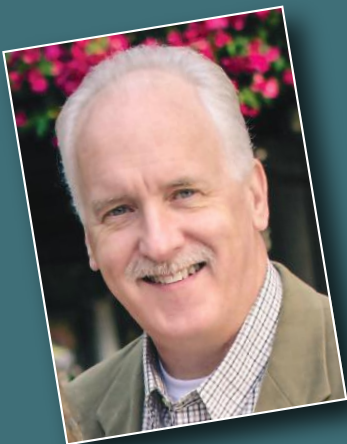

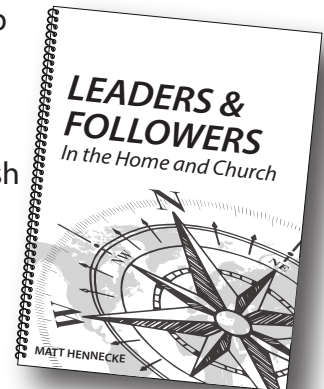

Leaders and Followers in the Home and Church

A Weekend Workshop - Session Summary

Length: 5 hours - these are highly interactive sessions (not sermons)

Schedule: Sessions can be done on a combination of Friday and Saturday, or all-day Saturday. Those attending *should attend all the sessions* as each session builds on the one before.

Audience: All Christians, men and women (and older teens). Parents can come with their little children – better for both parents to attend than one stay at home to watch the children.

SESSION 1: Defining Terms and the "Crucial" Factor of Leadership

The principles of truly effective leadership are found in the pages of the Word. Indeed, the greatest of all leaders, Jesus Christ, demonstrated the skills essential for those who would lead in their homes, in the church, and in even in business. In this session we will begin to examine the skills and attributes needed to be an effective leader and in doing so we'll uncover the most crucial factor needed by leaders.

SESSION 2: A Better, Practical Definition of Leadership

Thousands of books written about leadership, but few about followership. But here's the thing: all of us play the role of follower *more* than we play the role of leader. While following dominates our lives it doesn't dominate our thinking. In this interactive session using several Bible examples will help us define leadership in a new and practical way and discover more of us are leaders than we think.

SESSION 3: What Really Makes a Good Leader?

This session will explore the biblical attributes that really make good leaders and good followers. Participants will help to generate a master list of attributes and characteristics and discover two categories of biblical factors every good leader and good follower must possess.

SESSION 4: The Leadership Model with Bible Examples

This session will introduce the Leadership Model which reveals five different types of followers, and the leader style needed for each. We will explore how parents should lead their children as they grow and how church leaders should lead the different types of followers comprising a congregation. Several Bible examples will be examined.

SESSION 5: Modern Cases Studies and Servant Leadership

To practice our skills in identifying different types of followers and the leadership needed for each, we will explore several modern case studies. Additionally, we will discover the attributes of a "servant leader" which Christ demonstrated so perfectly and discover how to emulate his leadership in the home, the church, and in business.
